

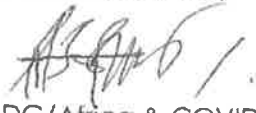

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**Removal of Restriction on Travel of inbound passengers to Sri Lanka**

Reference : Ministry's Cir. Msg. No 159 dated 20.05.2021 informing the suspension of all inbound passenger arrivals.

2. Please be informed that the temporary restrictions imposed (effective 11.59 pm 21 May 2021 to 11.59 31 May 2021) for inbound passenger arrivals to Sri Lanka will be removed w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> June 2021 and the related conditions that were effective before 21<sup>st</sup> May will remain unchanged.

3. Restriction will continue until further notice, on inbound passengers who have travelled to and /or remained in India within the past 14 days from the date of their intended return journey to Sri Lanka

4. All inbound passengers will be subjected to a mandatory quarantine of 14 days as per the guidelines of the DG/Health Services dated 11.05.2021 (Ends).
